

## HISTORIC MURRAY HILL - THE NATIONAL REGISTER DISTRICT BANNER MAP

The banner map for the National Register District is now on display throughout our Historic Community. The map depicts the outside boundaries of HISTORIC MURRAY HILL as defined by the National Register of Historic Places.



THE WHITE BOUNDARY OUTLINE indicates:

East boundary: just west of Third Avenue  
West boundary: East side of Madison Avenue  
South boundary: North side of 34th Street  
North boundary: South side of 39th

THE TWO BLUE AREAS depict

the two Historic Districts within National Register Historic District

THE YELLOW DOTS depict

fourteen Individually Landmarked Structures within the National Register Historic District. These structures have been selected and designated by the Landmark Preservation Commission by the NYC LANDMARKS COMMISSION.

The LPC was founded in 1965 by a group of dedicated New Yorkers after a massive human outcry about the demolition of architectural gem PENN STATION. Today there are 37,900 designated landmarks and 156 Designated Historic Districts in the City of New York.

Shown below are locations of the fourteen Individual Designated Landmarks.
